In anticipation of Earth Day, please join us for a special showcase of short films from Italy’s Strano Film Festival. Each film will be introduced by special guests, who will discuss how the work relates to the festival’s focus on “the land.”

The Strano Film Festival is an international short film competition held in Capestrano, Abruzzo, Italy. This region is one of the country’s most beautiful, including the Gran Sasso and Monti della Laga national parks, among the most breathtaking in Europe. Abruzzo is still strongly connected to agriculture and pastoralism and remains an alive land that has protected precious know-how and priceless heritage for everyone.

The Coolidge is proud to showcase three films from last year’s festival, which explore work done on the land, migration from one land to another, and the geology and transformation of the land.

The event will be introduced by two of the co-founders of the Strano Film Festival, and will also include an overview of the Tirino River by hydrologist Kate Bowditch and a film introduction by evolutionary biologist Dr. Nigella Hilgarth, who recently retired as CEO of the New England Aquarium.
